Your email address is securely stored in a Google Spreadsheet, which is accessible only to us. We implement the following security measures:

- · Restricted access to authorized personnel only.
- Use of strong passwords and two-factor authentication for accessing the data.

Google provides encryption for data in transit and at rest to help protect your information.

Data Sharing

We do not sell, rent, or share your personal data with third parties unless required by law.

How Long We Keep Your Information

We retain your email address for as long as you remain subscribed to our newsletter. If you unsubscribe, your email address will be deleted from our records within 30 days.

Your Rights

Under the UK GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- 1. Access: You can request a copy of the data we hold about you.
- 2. **Correction**: You can request that we correct any inaccurate data.
- 3. **Deletion**: You can request that we delete your data ("right to be forgotten").
